
Add a directory to your path of your FreeBSD shell

To add a path to your FreeBSD /bin/sh shell edit your `~/.shrc` (or `~/.profile`) file and add the following line:

```
export PATH=$PATH:$HOME/.composer/vendor/bin:
```

Previous line will add `~/.composer/vendor/bin` to your `$PATH`.

To check your new path, re-login to your sh shell and run:

```
echo $PATH
```

To add a path to your csh or tcsh shell add the following line to your `~/.cshrc`

```
set path = ($path $HOME/.composer/vendor/bin)
```

Notes: - To add your path to bash you need to edit `~/.bash_profile`. - export command will work with sh, ksh, bash. - set command (or setenv) will work with csh or tcsh.
