

See what version of FreeBSD is on your machine

You can see the version of FreeBSD reported by your kernel with `uname -a` but what if you want to see the version and the patchlevel of your machine? In that case you can use `freebsd-version` command:

```
# freebsd-version  
10.2-RELEASE-p8
```
