This example show you how to check if a string has a prefix or a suffix. For that we will use hasPrefix and hasSuffix methods:

```
main.m // check if a string has a suffix or a prefix#import <Foundation/Foundation.h>
```

int main (int argc, const char * argv[])
{

    @autoreleasepool {

        NSLog(@"Verify if a string begins with a prefix");

        NSString *str1 = @"This is a string";
        NSString *str2 = @"Just another string";

        if ([str1 hasPrefix:@"This"])
            NSLog(@"str1 has 'This' prefix: '%@'",str1);

        if ([str2 hasSuffix:@"string"])
            NSLog(@"str2 has 'string' suffix: '%@'",str2);

    }

    return 0;
}
```
