```

    @autoreleasepool {  
  
        NSString *str1 = @"This is a NSString string";  
        NSData *str2 = [str1 dataUsingEncoding:NSUTF8StringEncoding];  
        char const *str3 = str2.bytes;  
  
        printf("Our C string is: %s", str3);  
  
    }  
  
    return 0;  
}
```
