

Get Attributes of Files and Directories in OSX

You can get attributes of files and directories in OSX using GetFileInfo tool. For example you can see if a directory is a bundle for an app in OSX using GetFileInfo tool from Terminal command line:

```
GetFileInfo /Applications/iMovie.app
```

You will get:

```
directory: "/Applications/iMovie.app"  
attributes: avbstclinmedz  
created: 07/08/2011 18:52:51  
modified: 07/26/2011 14:13:48
```
